### June 13-18: Sikeston, MO

Working with Liberty House. Construction and repairs work. Stay in First UMC and Wesley in Sikeston. Open to grades 6-8. Cost: \$130/per person

Construction and repairs work. Stay in First UMC, Kennett. Open to grades 7-12. Cost \$130/per person

### June 20-25: Memphis, TN

Working with area agencies. Some construction and more. Open to grades 6-12. Cost: \$130/per person

### June 27-July 2: New Orleans

Construction and repairs to homes. Katrina recovery. Open to grades 9-12. Cost: \$130

Construction, food pantry, Habitat work, Open to grades 6-12. Cost: \$130, stay in Jeff City, work in Jeff and Columbia

Construction on homes /churches of persons who are members of Cherokee Nation. Open to grades 6-12. Cost: \$130

### July 25-30: Colorado: two options

All groups will have 2 days of work in the mountains on forest restoration from the Hayman fire and 2 days in Colorado Springs  
Housing: senior high groups can camp or stay at the church, mixed groups of 7-12 graders will stay at the church. Limit of 100 staying at the church and 75 camping. Cost: \$130 per person. Ratio 1:3 adult to

Youth. Optional river raft on Friday, \$40 extra.

### August 1-6: Colorado: two options:

Work same as week 1. Housing: senior high groups can stay at church or camp. Mixed or 7/8 grade groups will stay at church. If you bring a 7/8 grade group (this is available for this week only and not Colorado week 1), they will only work in Colorado Springs. Mixed groups and senior highs will have 2 days in each place. Limits are the same as week 1. Optional River Raft, \$40

## Important Information:

*Adult to Youth Ratio: 1 adult for every 4 youth,*

*New Orleans & Colorado sites: 1:3 **required.***

Need male and female adults when there are male and female youth. If you are going on the camping Colorado week, we will help to combine churches should there only be 3-4 from a church to help with adults and transportation.

***All adults must be Conference Safe Sanctuaries certified. You may do this online: [www.moumethodist.org/safesanctuaries](http://www.moumethodist.org/safesanctuaries). Begin to recruit adults and get them certified. Also check that their certification has not expired.***

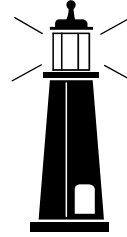
Churches are expected to participate in all activities, worship, & meals

*Adults and youth from the same church will work at the same site. The number per site is about 10-15. Larger groups will be asked to split into 2 or more groups.*

*Leadership is provided by Conference Council on Youth Ministries (CCYM). This is very much a youth-led mission.*

### **Registration Process:**

Decide which week you will attend. Mail the registration with a check for \$200 (non refundable), payable to "Missouri Conference UMC."

### **Cost: \$130 per person, including adults**

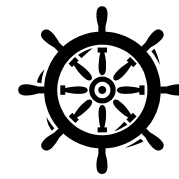
Includes all food, lodging, materials for the projects, activities, t-shirt and supplemental insurance.
