Ratios: June weeks 1 adult for every 4 youth. July (Joplin) 1 adult for every 3 youth. **All adults must be conference Safe Sanctuaries certified by May 1.** T

Transportation: Each church is responsible for their own transportation to the mission location and to the work sites each day. In Joplin the work sites will have about 10-12 people at each site.

Final Registration: Final numbers and adult skills and payment will be needed for all weeks on May 1.

Other important information:

Each church will be assigned to the same work sites. So the adults will be with the youth that they bring.

If you bring male and female youth, there must be male and female adults

Adults need to be prepared to give guidance and supervision to the youth while at worksites and where we stay, including lights out.

Typical Day:

About 6 am: Rise and Shine
7:30 am: Devo and leave for work site
4:30 pm: showers
6 pm: supper
Evening activities, worship
10:30 pm; lights out

Everyone is expected to participate in all evening activities, present and eat all meals provided, and attend all worship.

Cooperative spirit and flexibility are a must. Blessed are the flexible for they shall not be bent out of shape is a attitude to live by.

Leadership is provided by the Conference Council on Youth Ministries. Worship and activities will be led by the youth.

More information will be sent once a deposit is received with the registration. Register early to be sure of your first choice of place and week.

St. Louis, MO: June 12-16: Middle school only, present grades 5-9. working on homes, food pantries and other help agencies in the city. Cost: \$110

Colorado: June 17-22: Presently grades 6-12. working in the mountain with the Hayman fire restoration, near Woodland Park. Cost: \$130, rafting option is extra **FULL**

Tahlequah, OK: June 25-30: Presently grades 6-12. Working with Cherokee Nation on homes and churches of the Cherokee people. Each evening will be the opportunity for Cherokee culture experiences. Cost: \$130

Arlington, TX: July 1-6; Presently grades 7-12. Working with Mission Arlington. Half day of children day camp/backyard Bible school experience, half day working in the city with various ministries. There will be preparation for the children's portion prior to the week. Cost: \$130

Joplin, MO: July 8-13: Presently grades 9-12 rebuilding Joplin Cost: \$130

Registration Process: Complete the form in this brochure and mail with non-refundable deposit. Or register online at www.moumethodist.org/youth. Once you have registered you will receive a packet of information by email and by snail packet with forms, final registration information, as well as general information about the week.

Arrival and Departure: You arrive on the first date listed in the afternoon. Depart early the last date listed. More info is sent once you register.

Cost: Includes all food, showers, housing, t-shirts, cost of supplies for the projects, accidental insurance, and any fun activities that might be planned during the week.

Limits: Each week has a limit on the numbers. Please be as accurate as possible on the numbers. If you over estimate it could cause another church not be to able to go. Under-estimating could cause problems with the work sites, housing, etc.
