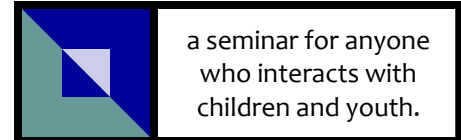

## Inside the World of Teenagers with Dr. Chap Clark

Inside the World of Teenagers is a combination of 2 different, but complimentary seminars led by Chap Clark. They are Parenteen and Hurt.

### **Parenteen**

With outside pressures from peers, parents, teachers and coaches, an ever changing social environment, and a growing culture of systematic abandonment from adults, this generation of adolescents has it tougher than ever. Inside the World of Teenagers is a seminar for the community by Chap Clark, Ph. D., a professor of Youth, Family, and Culture at Fuller Theological Seminary. Dr. Clark spent a year as a participant-observer at Crescenta Valley High School where he conducted an ethnographic study on teens.

Come hear the latest research on adolescent development, family and social systems, and the

rapidly-changing environment that every teen faces. This seminar is guaranteed to help parents gain insight into their child's journey and develop a more authentic and effective parenting strategy.

### **Hurt**

Specifically targeted at a broad range of adults and organizations - educators, social workers and government officials, counselors and therapists, youth workers and parents - to provide them with the training they need to understand the contemporary adolescent experience. As caring men and women from various institutions and organizations gather together to wrestle with what life is like for their young people, they are able to work together to undo the implicit tragedy of what our systemic, culture-wide neglect has put kids through.

The seminar features dynamic and thought-provoking presentation methods designed to draw all participants into the changing landscape of today's adolescent culture. This shared knowledge serves as a springboard to assist communities in the development and implementation of strategies that will help connect adult and teen populations.



**Chap Clark, Ph.D.,** Founder of **Parenteen and HURT Seminars**, is Vice Provost and professor of youth, family, and culture at Fuller Theological Seminary, a Red Letter

Communicator and contributing writer for *Sojourners*, and Senior Editor of *Youthworker Journal*.
